# **Spring Tides**

Sun's gravity pulls on Earth's waters

Sun

Moon

Earth

- During a new moon sun, moon and Earth are nearly in a line.
- Gravity of sun and moon pull in same direction
- Combination of forces produce tide with greatest difference between low and high tide
- Called a spring tide occur twice a month during full and new moons

## **Neap Tides**

- During moon's 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, line between Earth and the sun is at right angles to line between Earth and moon.
- Sun's pull is at right angles to moon's pull.
- Produces a neap tide = least difference between high and low tide
- Occur twice a month
